The school will reopen for the second term at **8.50am on Tuesday 7th January 2020.**

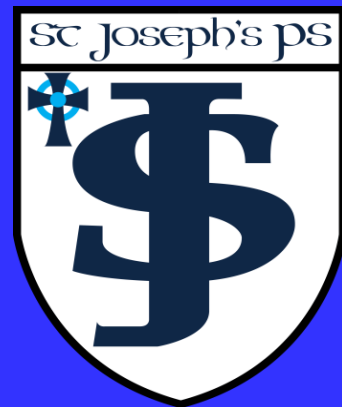
